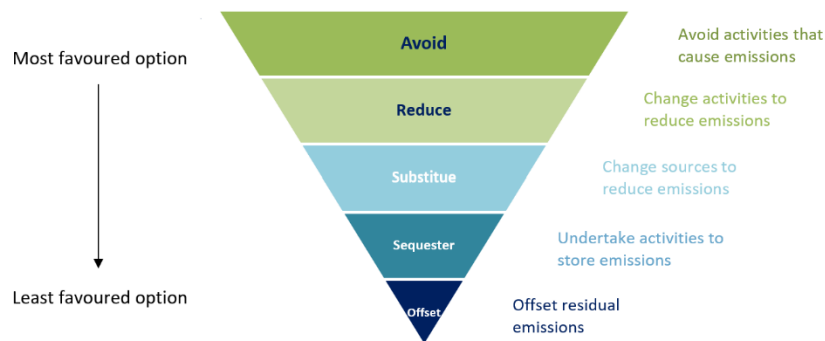




ENERGY POLICY

Seaforce is committed to reducing its Environmental Footprint and to achieving Carbon Neutrality by 2027.



At the start of each new Contract with a Client, a subcontractor or an employee Seaforce:

- Commit to starting and funding an Ecologi Account for each employee to sequester carbon and to create offsets; and
- Encourage and assist in the use of sustainable transport

The following guidelines apply to every Seaforce location:

- Install energy efficient bulbs and motion sensors;
- Make sure HVAC supply points aren't blocked by desks or drawers;
- Turn off all non-critical equipment at the end of each day - nothing left on standby;
- Fit draught excluders to all windows and doors;
- Keep lights and computer equipment free of dust and grime; and
- Discourage staff from printing documents

Seaforce recognises the significance of embedding environmentally sound practice in all of its policies with the commitment to Sustainable Procurement being one example of this.
